This totals \$1,300. We will inspect the equipment before we purchase it. However, we can not rent the same for this amount.

N-SCALE REPORT

May 15, 2018 - Altercare of Alliance - the N-TRAK section of Division 1's module group gave a presentation on rail-road history and model railroading to the facility's residents. The staff of Altercare decorated the entrance of the activities room with cardboard trains and a ticket booth shown below. Also photos of setup for presentation and residents operating ACY train are shown.









Program consisted of a slide show including information on the Steam/Turbine/Electric Locomotive Jawn Henry. Its assembly was completed at the B&W research facility which was located ¾ of a mile from the Altercare complex. Jawn Henry was 162' 1-1/2" long, required water of higher quality than fire tube boilers, had higher construction costs, ash fouling of non-enclosed electric traction motors and reported poor low speed & reverse operation doomed it.



In addition to the slide show there were static displays of Aultman Diorama, Sleeping Woman Mountain and operation on Kurt Sander's Coal Mining Modules with new hidden yard shown above. All was done with only 14 days notice. A letter of appreciation was sent to Division 1.


